## Matthew 18:20

20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

There are many who quote this saying of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ but never come to an understanding of multiplication in the way that He meant it. We understand that He is saying that if two or three of us down here on Earth gather together for the sake of prayers of agreement, church service, or praise and worship, that His presence would be there to help us and fight our battles for us. ## John 20:15-17

15 Jesus saith unto her, **Woman, why weepest thou? whom seekest thou?** She, supposing him to be the gardener, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take him away.

16 Jesus saith unto her, **Mary.** She turned herself, and saith unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.

17 **Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.**

Jesus telling Mary not to touch Him for He had not ascended unto the Father at the time, shows us the 2 or 3 factor. While He was down here on Earth, there were still 2 in Heaven, the Father and the Holy Spirit of God. God the Father is never left alone in Heaven and neither is His Holy Spirit left alone in Heaven. The "two" were sitting in Heaven on the Throne as the Son did what He had to do for man down here. Heaven is vast, Heaven is an Eternity! Heaven is the place that counts. All of life as we know it started there. Earth is just one of God's creations, even Genesis tells us that. The Sun, the Moon, the Stars, the sky, heavens, man, animals, waters, etc. We see this also in Acts 1:5 where Jesus tells the followers, "wait for the promise of the Father, which ye had heard of me. For John truly baptized with water, but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence." He is promising them that there is another Character of God, the Holy Spirit, who is coming to be with them when He leaves. We are never left alone. to us. Acts Chapter 2.

## Acts 2:0-21

### Acts 2

- 1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
- 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.
- 3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.
- 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- 5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.
- 6 Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.
- 7 And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilæans?
- 8 And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?
- 9 Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judæa, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia,
- 10 Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,
- 11 Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.
- 12 And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this?
- 13 Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.
- 14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judæa, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:
- 15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.
- 16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel;
- 17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:
- 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:
- 19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:
- 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:
- 21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Now, there are 2 characters of the Godhead in Heaven watching over us and 1 down here on Earth Who remains until the day of Jesus Christs return. The Holy Spirit is our Teacher and our Guide. He wants us to invite Him into our day when we awaken. He wants to be there to put us asleep at night after hearing our evening prayers. He's a Teacher, that's what He does. He listens to us and either He agrees with us or lovingly corrects. He is the Administrator of the Godhead, administrating us as we

attempt to live Holy as God is Holy.
